PIG SHOW - INFORMATION

All classes are held under the general rules and conditions recommended by the British Pig Association. Due to access difficulties on Show morning, all exhibitors must have their stock in place by 8.00 pm on Friday 26th May 2023, or prior to 8.30 am on show day, unless prior arrangements have been made.

AN ELECTRONIC ANIMAL MOVEMENT LICENCE (eAML2) issued under the Pigs (Records, Identification and Movement) Order 2011 must accompany all pigs. Appropriate movement licences and certification to be completed beforehand and must be handed to the Steward on arrival.

SPECIAL CONDITIONS: All pigs in classes P1 to P14 must be registered with the British Pig Association or equivalent society. Proper pig boards and sticks are required. Handlers are requested to be of smart appearance and white coats must be worn when exhibiting. Boars aged twelve months or more at the time of the show must have their tusks cut prior to the show and must be shown by two competent adult handlers who are equipped with protective boards.

Pens for pigs must be requested and paid for with entry please; kit pens will be allocated 1 kit pen per 2 exhibitors, provided free of charge. Registration numbers for each entry to be included on the entry form. All pigs to be the property of the exhibitor. The Stewards are responsible for the running of the section and their decisions will be final.

Judging will commence at 10.00 am, followed by the Breed Championships, Supreme Championship, pairs, group of 3 and junior handler. Exhibitors must not leave before 4.00pm. Proper pig boards and sticks are required. Handlers are requested to be of smart appearance and white coats must be worn when exhibiting.

CLASSES:

Any Traditional Breed: To include Gloucestershire Old Spot, British Saddleback, Berkshire, British Lop, Large Black, Middle White, British Lop, Oxford Sandy and Black, Tamworth. Pedigree registered pigs, registered with the 'The BPA' or relevant breed society. If there are sufficient entries of any particular breed, the stewards may split the classes. Please stipulate breed on entry form.

Class P1 Boar born after 1 July 2023
Class P2 Boar born after 1 January 2024
Class P3 Sow born on or before 31st December 2023
Class P4 Sow born between 1st January and 30th June 2023
Class P5 Gilt born after 1 July 2023
Class P6 Gilt born after 1 January 2024

Class PCH1 Winner of classes P1-P6 are eligible to compete for Traditional Breeds Champion Pig and Reserve Champion Pig.

Any Modern Breed: To include Large White, Landrace, Welsh, Duroc, Hampshire, Pietrain etc. Pedigree registered pigs, registered with the 'The BPA' or relevant breed society. If there are sufficient entries of any particular breed, the stewards may split the classes. Subject to enquiries some classes may be merged and prize money. Please stipulate breed on entry form.

Class P7 Boar born after 1 July 2023 Class P8 Boar born after 1 January 2024 Class P9 Sow born on or before 30th June 2023 Class P10 Gilt born after 1 July 2023 Class P11 Gilt born after 1 January 2024

Class PCH2 Winner of Class P7-P12 are eligible to compete for Modern Breeds Champion Pig and Reserve Champion Pig
