Equine Flu – Northumberland County Show

Equine Influenza and Tetanus vaccinations are a compulsory requirement for all pony/horses attending the Northumberland County Show. The requirement for the first 3 vaccinations is as follows: the first 2 vaccinations 21 – 92 days apart, a third booster between 150-215 days, and an annual booster vaccination within 365 days thereafter. No horse should enter competitions within 7 days of an El vaccination. This rule may be subject to change from guidance from the FEI/BEF and any changes will be notified via the www.northcountyshow.co.uk website.

In-foal mares that have already had vaccinations of primary Equine Influenza course should be vaccinated 4-6 weeks before the foal is due to be born. Foals should be vaccinated for Equine Influenza at 6 months to commence their primary course. We urge all owners to adhere to strict biosecurity protocols at all times.

PLEASE NOTE THAT NEITHER VACCINATION CERTIFICATES NOR PASSPORTS SHOULD BE SENT TO THE SHOW OFFICE PRIOR TO THE EVENT.

Open to members and non-members, 15 yrs and over, eligible under Rising Star Amateur rules. Please note: Rising Star Amateur Rules 2024 are separate to BSHA Amateur rules. - The Judge's decision is final.
- The Judge will NOT ride exhibits in these classes.

FINALISTS A qualification card will be presented in the ring detailing how to confirm qualification and register with the BSHA. The BSHA will offer training clinics nearer the event to prepare all competitors before the finals.

B.S.P.S. This Show is affiliated to the British Show Pony Society (BSPS), and all persons entering, competing, showing or otherwise taking part in BSPS classes, whether or not members of the BSPS are subject to the Rules of the BSPS, including the disciplinary procedures, and shall be deemed to have consented to the jurisdiction of the BSPS.

This Show is a qualifier for the 2024 B.S.P.S. Championships Show, to be held at Arena UK. The 1st and 2nd prize winners only in open classes in the following sections Show Ponies, Mini Show Ponies, Show Hunter, Working Hunter Ponies and Mini WHP and the 1st, 2nd and 3rd Prize-winners in the Open Intermediate S.R.T. (including Mixed height) W.H. and S.H.T. and C.S. and in MIXED HEIGHT CLASSES the 1st. 2nd. 3rd. and 4th placed ponies will qualify for the B.S.P.S. Championships Show, provided the animal is registered in accordance with Rules 21 and 26 and ridden by a B.S.P.S. member.

This show is a qualifier for the B.S.P.S. Blue Riband Pony of the Year, the 1st and 2nd prize winners in the Lead Rein, First Ridden OR Open Show Pony OR Open Working Hunter Pony OR Open Show Hunter Pony OR Open Intermediate WH SRT and SH Classes will qualify.

This Show is a qualifier for the BSPS Roger's Truck Services Ltd Challenge – see Rule 516. Animals competing in the following Open classes will qualify:- Open Lead Rein, First Ridden, Lead Rein Hunter Type, Show Pony, SHP, Cradle and Nursery Stakes, WHP, Intermediate SH, SRT and WH and Open Heritage Lead Rein, First Ridden, Ridden and WHP classes.

ROYAL INTERNATIONAL HORSE SHOW - This Show is a qualifier for the R.I.H.S. Only one pony in each of the three Open Intermediate SR, SH classes qualifies, and the highest placed, (not already qualified), from the first THREE ponies placed in each class will qualify. N.B. THE R.I.H.S. QUALIFICATION IS SUBJECT TO CONFIRMATION FROM B.S.P.S. HEAD OFFICE.

THE B.S.P.S. BINKS FAMILY CHAMPION OF CHAMPIONS - This show is a qualifier for the B.S.P.S. Binks Family Champion of Champions the 1st prize winners in the following classes will qualify:- Open Lead Rein, First Ridden, Lead Rein of Hunter Type, Show Pony, SHP, WHP, Intermediate SH, SRT and WH and Open Heritage Lead Rein, First Ridden, Ridden and WHP classes.

Owners and riders see Rules must be B.S.P.S. Members before the date of the show to qualify in classes with qualification for BLUE RIBAND & R.I.H.S. and animals must be registered with the B.S.P.S. Membership forms and payment must be received in the office no later than the last working day (Monday to Friday) prior to the date of the qualifying show. (See Rule 20)

Riders in BSPS classes will be required to adhere to rules 43 and 50 in the 2024 BSPS Rulebook with regard to hat specification, tagging and body protectors.

National Pony Society (NPS)

<u>NPS Qualifying Rounds</u>: These classes are judged under the Rules of the NPS. Ponies must be registered in any of the British Riding Pony studbook sections or the Ridden Register; the GSB; the AHSB; the AASB, or registered in the main body of their respective M&M Stud Book. Part breds are not eligible unless overstamped into one of the British Riding Pony studbook sections. or the Ridden Register. Qualifying rounds for most NPS competitions are open to ponies owned by NPS members and non-members but only ponies owned by adult NPS **Qualifying or Life** members are eligible to qualify for the final of the competition at the NPS Summer Championship Show at Malvern from $6^{th} - 8^{th}$ August 2024.

The highest placed pony, if owned by an NPS member, in each class will qualify for the final. Qualification may pass down to third place if the first and second ponies are already qualified.

NPS/Home Produced Ridden Championship - Riders of Home Produced ponies (see definition in the NPS Rules Book) can wear a white arm band in classes where this is indicated. These ponies, if owned by NPS members, are then eligible to qualify for the final at the NPS Summer Championship Show. The Owner's Membership cards **MUST** be produced in the ring when requested or the qualification will be forfeit.

<u>NPS Silver Medal Rosette Championships</u>: These classes are judged under the Rules of the NPS. NPS Silver Medal Rosettes are only awarded when the owner of the champion pony is a **Qualifying or Life member** of the NPS. A valid membership card must be in the rider's/handler's possession on entering the ring and be produced immediately on request by either the judge or the steward. If the owner of the Champion pony is not a member, or the owner's membership card is not immediately produced, the rosette may be awarded to the Reserve Champion provided they have the required membership card. If the Champion pony has previously qualified it is still entitled to the Silver Medal Rosette, but the qualification card goes to the Reserve Champion pony, provided the owner of that pony is a member of the NPS. The Silver Medal Rosette and the qualification card can be awarded no lower than first Reserve (third). Foals are not eligible for Silver Medal Championships.

This show is affiliated to The Coloured Horse & Pony Society (UK). Affiliation No. 24/094

Both owner and the rider/exhibitor need not be a member of CHAPS (UK) nor must the horse or pony be registered with CHAPS (UK) to compete. However, in order to qualify both Owner and Rider/Exhibitor need to be a current showing member and present their valid Qualifier card IN THE RING for signing by the judge. Members to apply in writing to CHAPS (UK) for appropriate qualifier card.

The CHAPS (UK) Championship Show will be held in August 2024.
