- Class 5*** Plain thumb stick. Wood, horn or antler
- Class 6** Fancy thumb stick. Wood, horn or antler with any carving or insert, may be painted or coloured
- Class 7*** Half-headed stick. Horn headed
- Class 8*** One piece plain natural wood head walking stick
- Class 9** One piece fancy natural wood head walking stick
- Class 10*** Best wood stick – novice
- Class 11*** Best horn or antler stick – novice
- Class 12*** Plain two piece wood head walking stick
- Class 13*** Fancy two piece wood head walking stick
- Class 14*** Fish stick. Wood or horn
- Class 15*** Ladies stick. Wood or horn
- Class 16*** Plain buffalo horn stick
- Class 17** Fancy buffalo horn stick
- Class 18*** Leg Cleek of working size. Wood plain
- Class 19*** Leg cleek of working size. Horn plain
