

Access Statement for Northumberland County Show

Introduction

At Northumberland County Show, we are committed to ensuring that all visitors have a positive and accessible experience. This access statement outlines the measures we have in place to support individuals with disabilities and other access needs.

Accessibility Features

1. Venue Access

- The showground is a grass field and so the ground is uneven in places, all efforts are taken to keep the ground flat and any areas of uneven surface will be identified.
- Nearest Railway station is Stocksfield, a short 5 min walk to the show ground
- Companion refund is now available online and can be refunded on show day at a designated pay booth (more details on the website)
- Visitors with hidden disabilities are advised to wear a sunflower lanyard or badge to help the show team to offer assistance if needed.
- The field is fully accessible, we don't have any paved pathways and ramps on the site.
- Accessible entrances are clearly marked, and signage is provided in large print on large showground maps around the site
- Marquees are clearly named with large print banners.
- Entrances are spacious

2. Parking

- Designated accessible parking spaces are available close to the entrance. Indicated on large directional signs
- All Vehicle routes are indicated by yellow directional signs
- Parking attendants will assist visitors as needed.
- All Parking is Free
- Toilets close to parking areas
- Golf Buggies available for assistance to car parks if needed.

3. Restroom Facilities

- Accessible restrooms are located throughout the venue, with clearly marked signage.
- Mobiloo Adult change unit is situated near the main entrance
- Disabled toilets indicated on the show map and situated close to entrances.
- Trailer units include separate ladies and gents, accessed by 3 steps with a single hand rail.
- Hand Washing facilities at trailer units and hand gels available
- Hand washing also available at livestock areas
- Multiple portaloos throughout the showground

4. Mobility Assistance

- Mobility scooters can use the site, however ground can be uneven
- Assistance by stewards can be arranged if needed through the secretary office.
- Show volunteers and staff will be trained to assist with mobility needs including guidance to key areas
- Marquees have spacious walkways, suitable for mobility vehicles and wheelchairs

5. Service Animals

- Service animals are welcome at the show. Please ensure they are clearly identified.

6. Quiet Spaces

- Designated quiet areas will be available for those who may need a break from sensory overload. This is situated behind the Castle entrance Information point (marquee)
